## Entrance Exams

All new music graduate students must take the entrance exams to determine if they need to take provisional classes in music history and theory. You may also choose to just take the provisional classes and skip taking the exams if you are certain you would not do well on the exams. See more info here:

All entrance exams will be held in the College of Fine Arts (CFA), 465 Rose Street, Lexington, KY 40506 in Room 107. As soon as you enter the college from Rose Street, Room 107 is on your left. If you enter the CFA from Patterson Drive, you need walk straight to the end of the building and go up one floor. Make a right at the stairs and you'll see Rm 107 on your left.

  - 8:30pm Written Theory
- Wednesday, August 16
  - 3:30pm Music History
  - 4:45pm Aural Theory
  - 5:30pm Written Theory

\*Please note that there are online versions of the exams reserved for students who live out-of-state, typically those in the MMME program. These are NOT meant for students in residence.

### Provisional Classes

- Music History: MUS 400G (online in the Fall)
- Aural Theory: MUS 471G (in person in the Fall)\*
- Written Theory: MUS 578 (in person in the Fall)\*

\*Please note that there are online sections of these courses reserved for students who live out-of-state or who live too far outside of town to attend a class in person. These are typically students in the MMME program. These online sections are NOT meant for students in residence.

# Advising

Dr. Vasil (the new Director of Graduate Studies) is your advisor your first semester. Dr. Brunner will also be helping her as the outgoing DGS. Both will hold a group advising session before classes start. Due to the large volume of students, it will not be possible to hold individual advising appointments for every student. After the first semester, your main professor in your program should be advising you every semester on a one-on-one basis.
